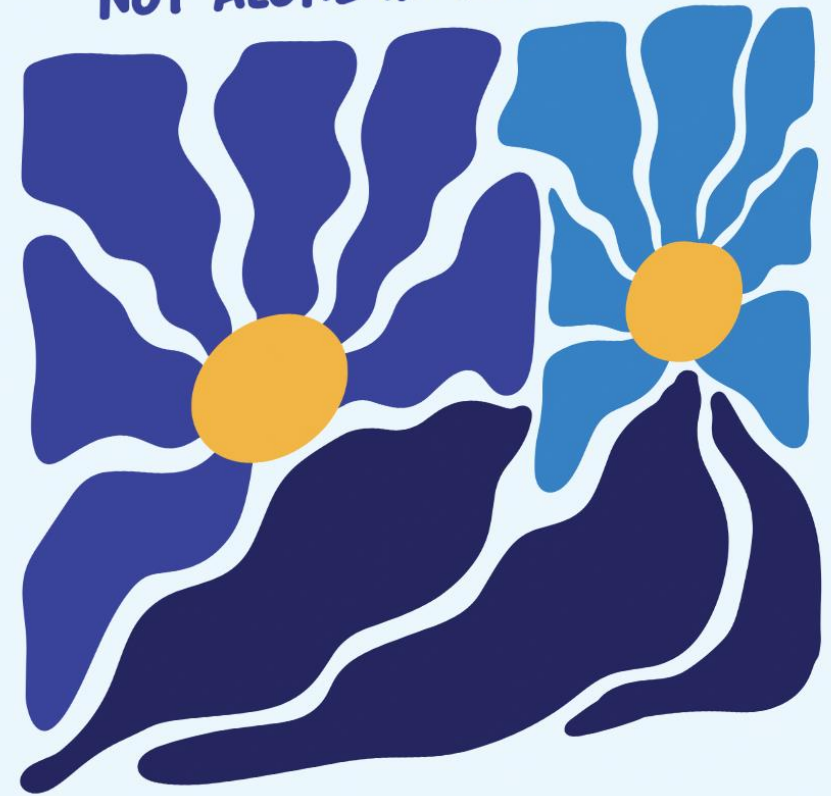
The Eisenhower Decision Matrix
