# OVERVIEW OF DSA-JC

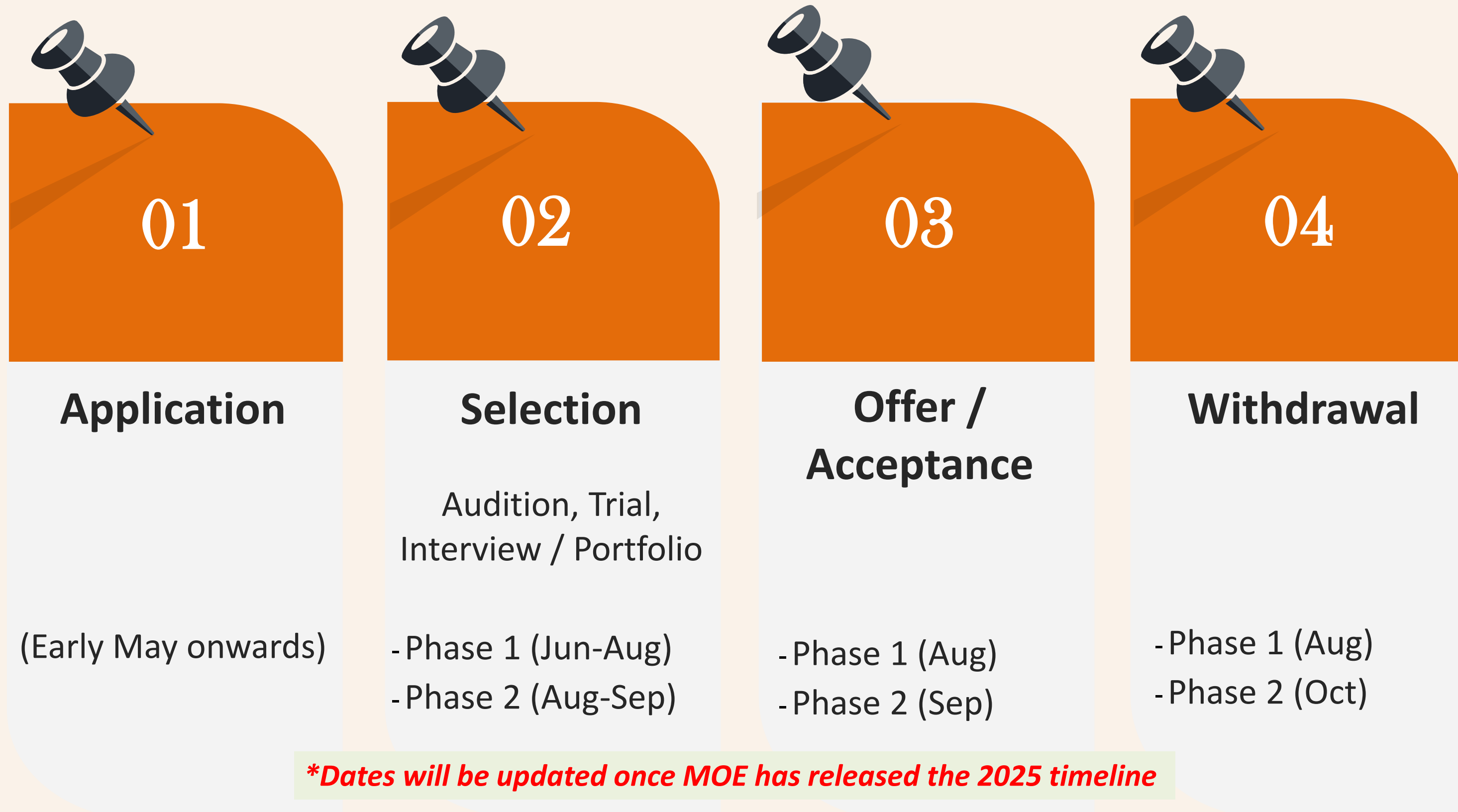
- ❖ Refer to participating schools' websites for specific details as each school's requirements varies
- ❖ Some possible talent areas:-
  - Sports (e.g. Top 4 finish in zonal inter-school competitions) OR
  - Performing Arts (e.g. SYF participation and awards received) OR
  - Leadership (e.g. school-wide leadership or record of effective leadership) OR
  - Debate (e.g. national or zonal competitions) OR
  - Academic (e.g. science research, mathematical Olympiads or proficiency/achievements in art/music/languages)
- ❖ Interviews and/or Selection trials may be conducted\*
  - Trials and Auditions are conducted either In-Person or Online; refer to participating JC for details
- ❖ *Some schools may require 2 rounds of interviews: 1 individual and 1 group*

- If the student changes his/her mind after accepting the posting, he/she must withdraw by submitting online at the EAE portal by the withdrawal deadline.





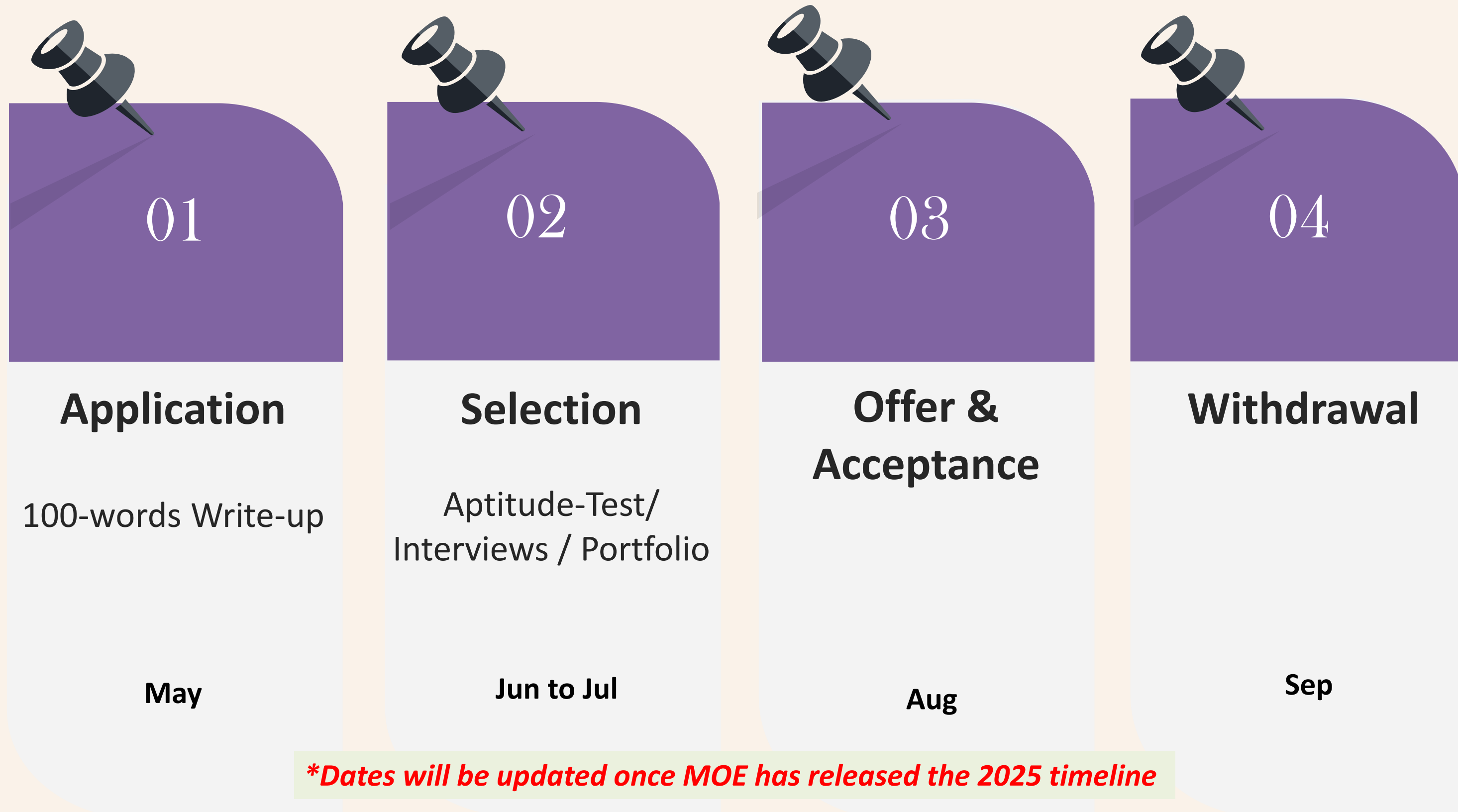

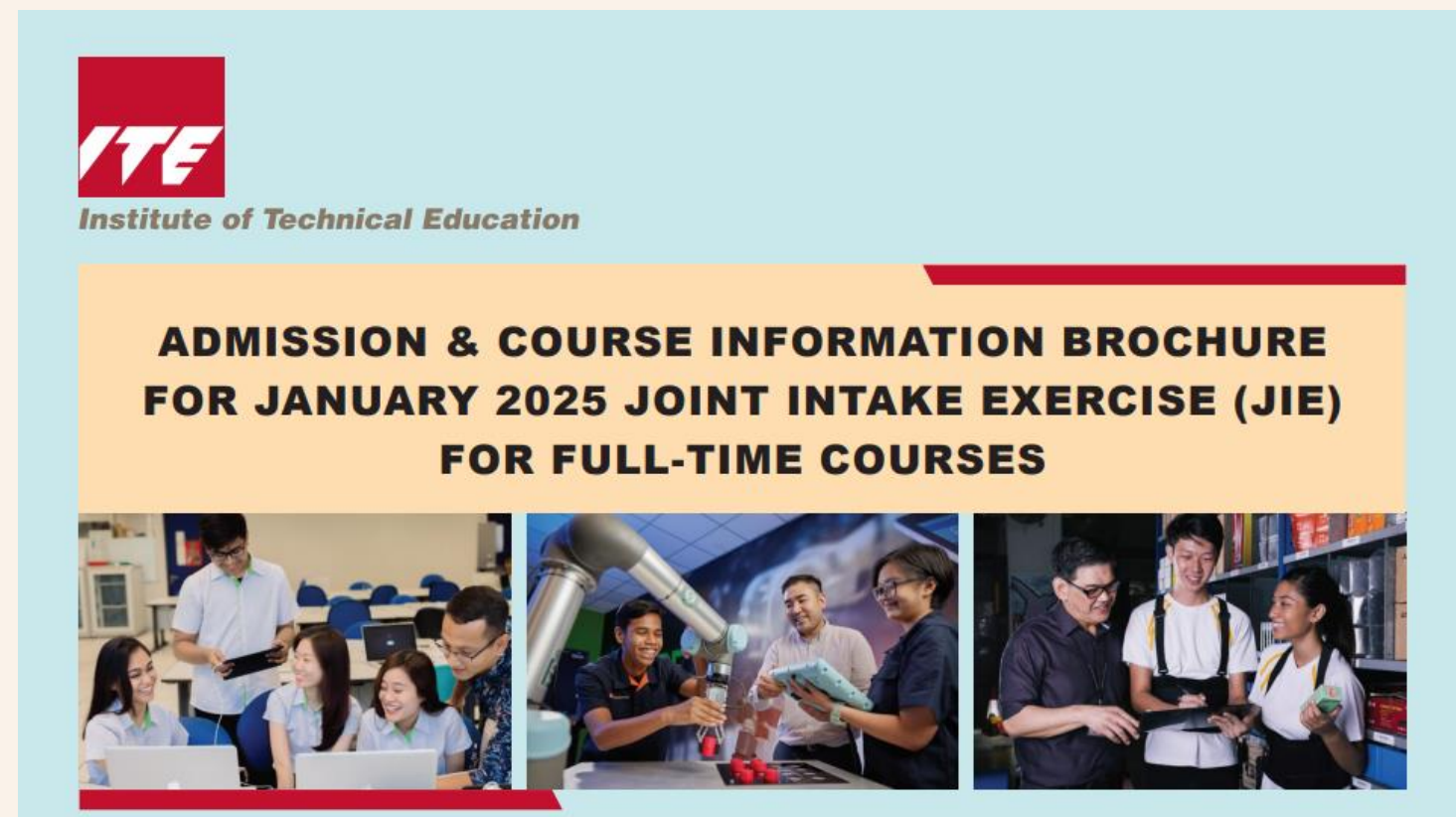
