Promotion Criteria for Sec 2 Express Students

Attainment Level	Movement
Minimum Attainment Level Pass in EL and a pass in overall percentage of all subjects combined	Promoted to Sec 3 Express

Progression Criteria - Sec 2 Normal (Academic)

Attainment Level	Movement
Minimum Attainment Level Grade 5 or better in (a) English and 2 other subjects or (b) 4 subjects	Promoted to Sec 3 N(A)
70% or higher in the average of all subjects * and deemed suitable by the school	Lateral transfer to Sec 3 Exp

Progression Criteria - Sec 2Normal (Technical)

Attainment Level	Movement
Minimum Attainment Level Grade D or better in 2 subjects, one of which must be EL or Maths	Promoted to Sec 3 Normal (Technical)
70% or higher in the average of all subjects * and deemed suitable by the school	Lateral transfer to Sec 2 Normal (Academic)

Subject Combinations

- Allocation of Secondary Three Subject Combinations is based on the following:
- 1. Merit
- 2. Student's choice
- 3. Vacancy
- 4. Minimum class size (15-20 students)
- Students are advised to choose their Secondary Three Subject Combinations based on their:
 - Interests, Strengths, Abilities and Future Plans

Subjects/Category	Prerequisites
8 subjects (Triple Science)	At least an overall percentage of 60 and At least an overall percentage of 60 for Science
Pure Sciences (Pure Chemistry or Pure Physics or Pure Biology)	At least an overall percentage of 60 for Science
Additional Mathematics	At least an overall percentage of 60 for Mathematics
Pure Literature	At least an overall percentage of 60 for English Literature
Pure Geography	At least 50 marks in Geography for End of Year Examinations At least an overall percentage of 50 for Geography
